

Off-Hire Guidelines

For a smooth off-hire, we recommend you follow the below guidelines.

- There must be clear access for our drivers to safely collect the equipment, which must be in the same area that it was delivered.
- If a toilet has been moved from where it was originally delivered, for example being placed over a wall, you must ensure that it is moved back prior to collection or assist our drivers when they arrive. It is not the drivers' responsibility to bring equipment back over walls and other obstructions. Please do not use the toilet after the off-hire date as we cannot collect toilets which are still in use or filled with waste.
- Containers must be empty and, if supplied with keys, these are left alongside the equipment.
- Fencing has been stacked and banded, if required, and placed on the ground where it was delivered. There should also be staff on-site to help load the vehicle and sign the collection note.
- The ground on-site is hardstanding.
- Keys or accessories are left with the plant for collection.
- Generators are disconnected, and all cables/accessories have been placed at the same collection point.
